

# 2008 – 2009 WHCA DRESS CODE

THE DRESS CODE IS AS FOLLOWS:

## Dress Code for Girls 7th -12th

### Shirts

Solid white, navy, or red knit collared shirts, oxford shirts, or overblouses may be worn. These may be short-or-long sleeved. Students may wear either white, navy or red crewneck shirts or turtlenecks under these shirts, if they wish. Oxford shirts are to be worn tucked in. Straight-hem shirts and overblouses may be worn untucked, but must be credit card length below the waistband of the pants. A tucked undershirt or body suit in any of the above-mentioned colors is to be worn underneath uniform shirts each day.

### Pants

Pants are to be solid navy or khaki, size-appropriate (no tight-fitting). Capri pants may be worn, but must be no shorter than mid-calf in length.

### Skirts, Skorts, and Jumpers

These must be solid khaki or navy. Length may be no shorter than two inches above the knee and size appropriate, not tight-fitting.

### Belts

Belts are not required unless needed to properly secure pants around the waist. If worn, belts should be brown, black, or navy. No decorative or western-style belts allowed.

### Shoes

Tennis shoes; brown, black, or navy shoes may be worn. Tennis shoes are required on students P.E. days. Heels of shoes can be no more than two inches in height.

### Socks

White or colored short or knee-high socks that coordinate with the outfit are to be worn. Socks are required.

### **Spirit Day**

Each Friday, students are permitted to wear any WHCA logo tee shirt or sweatshirt; this includes school-sponsored or fundraising shirts (retreat, fish fry, etc.)

### **Jackets**

Non-uniform jackets may be worn, if they have a zip or button front. No inappropriate wording allowed. WHCA sweatshirts are acceptable as outerwear, with appropriate shirt worn underneath.

### **Hats and Caps**

Hats are not allowed to be worn inside the school building. Winter caps are acceptable only for outdoor physical education classes.

### **Hair**

Must be cleaned and well-groomed. Hair that is unusually colored is not allowed.

### **Earrings**

One pair of earrings may be worn in the earlobes. Earrings may be no larger than two inches in diameter. All other piercings must be filled with a clear spacer.

### **Dress Code for Boys 7th -12th**

#### **Shirts**

Solid white, navy, or red knit collared shirts or oxford shirts may be worn. These may be short-or-long sleeved. Students may wear either white, navy or red crewneck shirts or turtlenecks under these shirts, if they wish. Oxford shirts are to be worn tucked in. Straight-hem shirts may be worn untucked, but must be credit card length below the waistband of the pants. A tucked undershirt in any of the above-mentioned colors is to be worn underneath uniform shirts at all times. Oversized, ill-fitting shirts are not allowed.

#### **Pants**

Pants are to be solid navy or khaki, size-appropriate (no tight-fitting or sagging.)

### **Belts**

Belts are not required unless needed to properly secure pants around the waist. If worn, belts should be brown, black, or navy. No decorative or western-style belts allowed.

### **Shoes**

Tennis shoes; brown, black, or navy shoes may be worn. Tennis shoes are required on students P.E. days.

Socks White or colored socks that coordinate with the outfit may be worn. Socks are required.

### **Spirit Day**

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### **Hair**

Hair must be cleaned and well-groomed. Hair that is unusually colored is not allowed.

### **Piercings**

All piercings must be filled with a clear spacer.
